„Red Ball Express" was the codename for one of the largest logistical operations of the Second World War. It consisted of a fleet of almost 6000 trucks and trailers which delivered ammunition, supplies and fuel from Normandy to the Allied armies on the Western European Front from the $25^{\text {th }}$ of August to the $16^{\text {th }}$ November 1944.

The trucks of the "Red Ball Express" brought 412.000 tons of military goods to the front over a span of 81 days.
